CALL FOR PAPERS

Within the framework of the research project "Towards a model of social justice: political-criminal alternatives", funded by the Ministry of Science, Innovation and Universities of the Government of Spain (Ref. RTI2018-095155-A-C22), the International congress entitled "Aporophobia and Criminal Law in the Social State" (April 20-22, 2021, University of Deusto, online) opens the following call for papers..

Professors, researchers and PhD students from Spanish and foreign universities can send communications.

The **thematic areas** of communications are the following:

- Social exclusion and criminal responsibility
- o Discrimination due to aporophobia as a criminal aggravation
- Social exclusion and trifle crimes
- The criminalization of immigration
- Criminal protection of labor rights
- o Vulnerability in the Penal Code
- Social exclusion and hate crimes
- Social exclusion, gender and criminal law
- o Social exclusion, environment and criminal law
- Other manifestations of the criminal law of aporophobia

Papers will be evaluated by a scientific committee. The recommended extension of the paper is five pages (Times New Roman, 12, single line spacing, citation format in APA). Regarding to international character of the Congress, papers can be written in Spanish or English. The deadline to send papers is April, 1st, 2021. The email for receiving communications is demolsa.benito@deusto.es Please put in the subject "Communication congress aporophobia".

The list of accepted papers will be made public on April 12, 2021. The selected communications will be presented orally and live during the days of the congress. They will have a maximum duration of ten minutes. It will be a requirement to be registered in it.

Likewise, the selected communications will be eligible to be published in the second issue of *Sistema Penal Crítico* journal after the corresponding anonymous peer review process. For publication, a paper must be sent on the subject matter of the communication, the length of which will be between 10 and 15 pages, in Spanish or English, with the style rules indicated below.

1) Format and name of the article

Papers must be submitted in Word format. They should be sent to sistemapenalcritico@usal.es

The name of the document will be given by the initials of the author's name and surname, followed by a hyphen and the abbreviation of the type of article in question: studies: Est .; comments: Com .; reviews: Res.). Examples: IGD-Est.docx .; APC-Com.docx; WPG-Res.docx. Reports, final degree or final master's degree projects, and communications are excluded from this requirement.

2) Drafting rules

The length will be between 10 and 15 pages, as they are communications selected to be published within the framework of a Congress.

They should be written in Times New Roman, 11, single spacing (1 pt.), With space between paragraphs of 6 pt.). The text must be justified to the right. Footnotes will also be written in Times New Roman font, size 10 and single spacing (1), without space between paragraphs.

The different sections of the work must be individualized with Arabic numerals that distinguish sections (1), 2), 3)...) and subsections (1.1), 1.1.1)...).

3) Author details

At the beginning of the work, it must be indicated:

- o Name and surnames of the author
- o Institutional affiliation, company or university to which it belongs
- o Project in which the article, if applicable, of the funding body is framed.
- o Declaration of originality of the article and of absence of previous publication

4) Presentation of the article

After the author's data, they must include, in this order:

- o Title of the article in Spanish (or in English, if this is the language of the article).
- o Title of the article in another language (English -preferably-, Italian or Portuguese). If the article is written in English, the second language must be Spanish, necessarily.
- An extract in Spanish and in a second language of those mentioned, of a maximum of 15 lines.
- o A list of three to five keywords in both languages
- o A summary with Arabic numerals (1, 1.1, 1.1.1,...)

5) References

In any case, due to the demands of academic honesty, the sources and bibliographic references should be included in footnotes and in a final section of bibliographic references.

The bibliographic references, both at the foot and in the final section of the work, must follow the international system UNE-ISO 690: 2013.

The deadline for submitting these works is June 15, 2021. The magazine will be published at the end of 2021.
